## Dear Ms. Kanning,

First, I must thank you and your church committee for the generous donation of 10 gift cards. Second, I must apologize for the delay in getting back to you. We were sailing along, mailing packages and then the roof at our location, which had been leaking for a while, developed a MAJOR leak and we had to vacate the premises to save our donations. Most of our inventory is now stored in rental storage lockers and at the homes of volunteers. Work is progressing slooooowly, and we still have no idea when we can return to this location. As a result, packing boxes has stopped for the time being. I have your gift cards stored safely at my house for the present.

We have found that Chaplains are excellent stewards of gift cards. When deploying Chaplains come to visit us and pick up items to go with them on deployment, we often give them a few gift cards. Reports back from these Chaplains have been heartwarming on how they were used. One group was having a terrible time with "sandstorms" and since we are not allowed to send any medications (OPSEC rules) we were able to send gift cards so they could order from Amazon. Made no sense to us why Amazon could send eye drops but we couldn't, but the bottom line was the soldiers had relief from sandy eyes! They were very grateful.

We have a few Chaplains coming in the next week to meet our Director at the storage center to pick up items to go to deploying troops and we will probably give them a few gift cards also.

We also have troops deployed to the border and they find it dry, hot, and dusty. There were 8 Chaplains who were able to provide a cold drink for their troops on a hot day thanks to gift cards we sent to them. We received a delightful letter from the Chaplain in Charge about how much the soldiers were surprised and thankful for such a nice treat.

I hope this provides you with some peek into how we are distributing gift cards we receive. Many of the cards we sent to the Chaplains are indeed given to individual soldiers so they can communicate with their families as needed.
