Sunday, May 29th our church celebrated Hope Raymond's 6th birthday. She attends weekly with Patty Huff who baked her a cake that Hope shared with everyone at lunch after church.

AS I SEE IT June and July are the months our Missions Committee focuses our attention on a very important part of our community - The Shelter for Abused Women and Children in Collier County. Domestic violence and human trafficking impact our whole community. The impact of domestic violence and human trafficking reaches far beyond the victims, because violence at home does not stop at the front door. It infects our workplaces, schools, places of worship, and other social places where people gather. It endangers our whole community and costs us tens of millions of dollars in medical care, social services, lost wages, and productivity. Last year there were 1,516 calls to 911 for domestic violence offenses in Collier County alone. Thousands more incidents went unreported. We all know the devastating cost to victims, but to quantify the monetary cost to our community, The Shelter worked closely with national consultants, local law enforcement, Collier County government and healthcare officials. In 2021, the estimated cost of domestic violence in Collier County equaled \$30.2 million dollars conservatively. Law enforcement costs were 18.5 million, medical costs exceeded \$8.5 million and local businesses sustained over \$3 million from lost workdays and productivity. In addition to costing us millions of dollars each year, abusers and traffickers pose a direct threat to our public safety, as the abuse and exploitation inevitably seep out into various aspects of our public life. The cost of domestic violence in Collier County is high, both financially and socially, but with your help, we believe we can stop this generational cycle of abuse for generations to come. Your support for the shelter is a personal investment in the safety of your family and loved ones; for as long as abusers perpetrate violence on their victims, they will continue to perpetrate violence in our community. I'm asking for your generous support for this worthy cause. The monies provided now will be used for school supplies and clothing for each child under their care when they begin preparing to return to school this Fall. So, June and July monies will be sent for that use in August. 
