AS I SEE IT . . . Almost every church has an "All Are Welcome" sign out front. Ours does. But, does anybody take it seriously. Think about it. If you didn't go to church, would you take that as much of an invitation? Next time you drive by a church, ask yourself "What would it take to convince me that I can walk in, uninvited, and participate in what they're doing?" Unchurched people may think about walking into a church the way you might think about walking into a wedding to which you weren't invited. It would be uncomfortable, to say the least. About the only way non-Christians, or the un-churched, will show up at a church is by being given a personal invitation. Regardless of what a sign might say out front, the real welcome comes from church members. And that's where we are as a church right now. Our Sunday attendance has never been lower. Our offerings have never been lower. Our enthusiasm has never been lower. Why? We are losing people because they are dying, moving away, or have just stopped coming and giving to the church. This isn't good for the church. And it isn't good for the individual church member. Looking ahead to next Season, we have fewer people in leadership roles right now than we ever have. And will have even fewer by this Fall. It's wonderful when our Seasonal folks return for four to six months. They are tremendous help! However, our church is a twelve-month church! What can we do? What MUST we do to change this? We need folks who are *year-rounders* willing to step up to the plate, right now, and say, "Here I am! You can count on me to assume a leadership role. I don't care what it is. I can be trained." Our Nominating Committee will soon be tasked with filling a lot of vacant places in our church for the coming year. We need to hear from everyone who will help us take this church forward.
