The Oasis After School Program

Oasis is an educational after-school program for kids in Vicente Guerrero, Baja California Mexico that began in August 2011. They provide a safe place for kids after classes to receive help with their homework, learn about the Bible, eat a hot meal, have an English class, and enjoy free time to play. They encourage kids to excel in school and they equip them with the resources to succeed. There are three locations in the Valley with 250 students ages 6-18 enrolled in the program. There is a growing wait list. The program is co-sponsored by various families and churches in the U.S., local Mexican businesses and the U.S. non-profit organization Oasis in Baja Inc. Everglades Community Church has been helping with this continuing project of providing needs, feeding the children, and helping them with their studies and counseling. We were blessed to have Monte Collins, Mike, and Wanda's son, come to our church last year and give us an update on the efforts being made to continue with the missions at Oasis. Our church has been blessed to have the Collins family give us the opportunity to be a small part of this mission over the years. WHAT IS THE MEANING OF LENT?

Lent is a 40-day season in the Christian calendar, observed by various denominations. It begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. Lent is a period of preparation leading up to Easter, celebrating the Lord's Resurrection. It's a time for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. The 40 days symbolize Jesus' 40 days of fasting in the wilderness. The Practices of Lent are Prayer - devoting yourself to seeking the Lord through prayer and reading Scripture. Fasting - abstaining from luxuries and practice self-control. Almsgiving -. sharing God's gifts through acts of charity and service. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Remember, Lent invites you to wait, reflect, and prepare your heart for the miracle of Christ's resurrection. The color for the altar paraments during Lent is Purple.
